

CONSTITUTION OF THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY of ST LUCIE COUNTY, FL

ARTICLE I: NAME AND OBJECT

Section I NAME

The name of this organization shall be Libertarian Party of St Lucie County hereinafter referred to as LPSLC.

Section II OBJECTS AND PURPOSES

The object and purpose of the LPSLC is to engage in political action In St. Lucie County, Florida, and to serve as an affiliate organization to the Libertarian Party of Florida to assist and support political efforts from the Libertarian Party of Florida.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Section I MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

Membership in the LPSLC is open to citizens of St. Lucie County who have signed the statement: "I hereby certify that I do not believe in or advocate the initiation of force as a means of achieving political or social goals." (commonly referred to as the Non-Aggression Pledge, and referred hereinafter as NAP) and who have requested membership. Any member may relinquish membership by written intent being delivered to the chair.

Section II REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Any membership may be considered for revocation after the member has missed 12 consecutive meetings or by a 2/3 vote of the Executive Committee if it should find the member has violated the NAP. Revocation for violating the NAP may be reconsidered by appeal to the Executive Committee.

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Article IV: AFFILIATION WITH THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY OF FLORIDA

The Constitution and Bylaws of the Libertarian Party of Florida are adopted.

ARTICLE V: OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section I OFFICES

The officers of the LPSLC shall be a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary and a Treasurer. These persons will be the members of the Executive Committee.

Section II EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Committee chairs, whether elected or appointed, will also be members of the Executive Committee.

Section III ELECTION

Officers shall be elected for a term of two years by a majority vote of active members at the annual meeting of the year to be held in January or February at the end of the specific term.

Section IV EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REQUIREMENTS

All members of the Executive Committee must be registered to vote Libertarian and be a member of the Libertarian Party of Florida (hereinafter LPP) and remain registered Libertarian and maintain their membership in the LPP.

Section V CHAIR

The chair shall preside over meetings. The term of office of the Chair shall start and end on odd numbered years.

Section VI VICE-CHAIR

The Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the Chair in conjunction with, or in the absence of, the Chair. The term of office of the Vice-Chair shall start and end on even numbered years.

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Section VII SECRETARY

The Secretary shall keep records including, but not limited to: minutes of meetings records of membership, and official correspondence. The Secretary shall insure members are informed of meetings and events. The Secretary shall perform the duties of the Chair in the absence of the Chair and the Vice-Chair. The term of office of the Secretary shall start and end on odd numbered years.

Section VIII TREASURER

The Treasurer shall be the chief financial officer and shall receive, hold, disburse and account for all funds under the direction of the Executive Committee. The Treasurer shall file all required accounting reports to the proper place in a timely manner. The Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Chair in the absence of the Chair, The Vice-Chair, and the Secretary. The term of office of the Treasurer shall start and end on even numbered years.

Section IX RESIGNATION OF OFFICERS

Any officer may resign his/her office by delivering written resignation to any other member of the Executive Committee. Any officer who shall allow his/her membership to become inactive shall be deemed to have resigned his/her office.

Section X EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPLACEMENT

The Chair shall have the authority to appoint a replacement to fill vacated offices. Such appointments shall be required to be confirmed at the next meeting, unless the next meeting is the January meeting, in which case the officer shall be required to be elected to serve a new term or the remainder of the existing term.

Section XI RECALL

Members of the LPSLC may recall any executive committee officer with a two-thirds majority vote.

ARTICLE V: STANDING COMMITTEES

Section I STANDING COMMITTEES

There shall be four standing committees: Finance, Communications, Membership, and By-Laws.

Section II APPOINTMENT TO COMMITTEES

Committee chairs shall be appointed by the Chair and serve at the discretion of The Chair. The Chair shall be a member ex-officio of all committees.

Section III COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Committee membership shall be the responsibility of the committee chair, with the exception of those in Section IV. The Vice-Chair shall be a member of the Membership Committee. The Treasurer shall be a member of the Finance Committee. The Secretary shall be a member of the Communications Committee. The Chair shall be a member of the By-Laws Committee.

Section IV FINANCE COMMITTEE


The Finance Committee shall be responsible for assisting the Executive Committee with identifying ways to generate income for the LPSLC and for maximizing the effect of LPSLC expenses.

Section V COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE

The Communications Committee shall be responsible for assisting the Executive Committee with keeping the membership informed, and for public communication outside the LPSLC.

Section VI MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

The Membership Committee shall be responsible for assisting the Executive Committee with membership growth and retention efforts.

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Section VII BY-LAWS COMMITTEE

The By-Laws Committee shall be responsible for assisting the Executive Committee with the execution of the By-Laws, and proposing such amendments as may be needed.

Section VIII OTHER COMMITTEES

The Executive Committee shall have the authority to create other committees provided such designation states membership requirements, the committee chair, term and mandate. The Executive Committee shall have the right to dissolve committees so created.

ARTICLE IV: ADOPTION AND AMENDMENTS

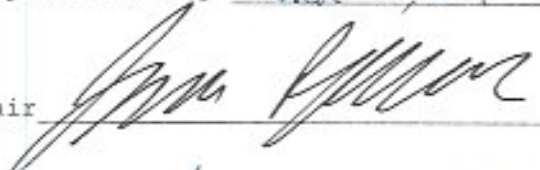
Section I
